Light it Right — A Compact Fluorescent Lamp (CFL) School Fundraiser



Schools in the PG&E service area have an opportunity this academic year to participate in a CFL light bulb fundraiser. While making money for school activities students also make a difference for the environment.

CFLs for the fundraiser are provided by PG&E without charge and therefore all the money raised belongs to the classes or the schools that participate. A one -hour **Light It Right** workshop, an educational guide for teachers, and a colorful activity book for students are all part of this fundraising program.

Energy Patrol

To get started, interested teachers and administrators of grade 4 through middle school students attend a two-hour energy patrol training workshop. At the workshop participants receive an Energy Patrol Handbook with step-by-step instructions, two classroom videos, and energy educational materials. They learn how to conduct an energy monitoring activity in the classrooms and throughout the building. Each school receives on-going support as they implement their energy-saving patrol program.



Energy Patrol:

An energy patrol is a group of students who have a real-life activity by monitoring energy waste in classrooms and other parts of the school. These students help schools save energy, reduce utility bills, and conserve natural resources.
